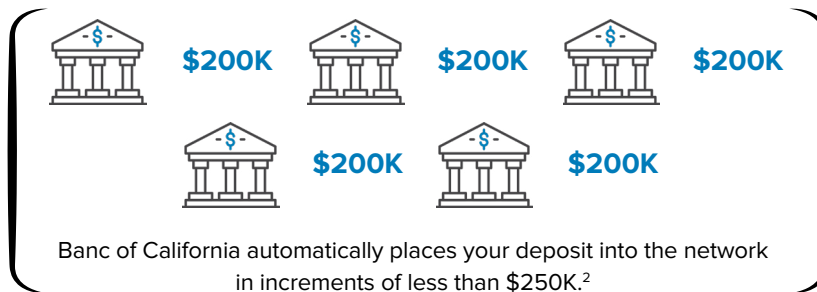

IntraFi Cash Service (ICS[®]) is a smart, convenient way to safeguard your large deposits. With ICS, your deposit is divided into amounts less than \$250,000. Your funds are then placed into deposit accounts at multiple FDIC-insured banks. You get FDIC coverage from many institutions while working directly with us, a bank you know and trust.

- Access the secure Depositor Control Panel (DCP) to check balances, review and manage fund placements, and view transaction history.

How It Works

1. Identify an existing Banc of California account for the sweep, and complete our ICS agreements.
2. You'll receive confirmation that the sweep is set up, and instructions on accessing the DCP.
3. Funds are deposited into the ICS account, and distributed to other ICS Network banks in amounts less than \$250,000.
4. Check balances, and see where your funds are using the DCP.
5. Get consolidated interest payments and one monthly statement available in Online Banking.
